- There were four civilian fire casualties, one of which was severe, but no civilian fire deaths occurred. There were three fire service casualties, one of which was a severe lost time injury.
- There were 667 Occupancy pre-incident surveys and 312 hydrant inspections completed twice during 2008.
- Approximately 2,500 children ages 3 to 8 were educated during October's Fire Prevention month using 33 educational sessions. An additional 750 children participated in the educational sessions offered during the Safekids campaign in March.
- Forestry responded to 83 incidents, Meducare responded to 42 incidents, and Lifereach responded to 18 incidents during 2008.
- Station 14 & 20 responded to 91 incidents that were not medical assists.
