\*Ambulance responses are no longer tracked separately and have been consolidated into "Medical Assists" total which caused a significant decline in the incident volume total. Non-emergent vehicle lock-outs were discontinued prior to 2009 which accounts for another significant decline in total incident volume.

- There were sixteen civilian fire casualties, including one civilian fire death. There were four fire service casualties, one of which was a minor lost time injury.

- There were 667 occupancy pre-incident survey updates and 332 hydrant inspections completed twice during 2009.

- Approximately 2,500 children ages 3 to 8 were educated during October's Fire Prevention month using 33 educational sessions. An additional 750 children participated in the educational sessions offered during the Safekids campaign in March.

- Stations 14 & 20 responded to 50 incidents that were not medical assists.
