<p><i>*Ambulance responses are no longer tracked separately and have been consolidated into "Medical Incidents"-- \$ amounts in thousands</i></p> <p>- There were twelve civilian fire casualties, including one incident with five casualties and another incident involving a death. This was the first civilian fire death in a structure since 2009. There were six fire service casualties, four of which were moderate severity, lost time incidents.</p> <p>- There were 762 occupancy pre-incident survey updates and 382 hydrant inspections completed twice during 2013.</p> <p>- Approximately 2,800 children ages 3 to 9 were educated during October's Fire Prevention month using 37 educational sessions.</p> <p>- There were 105 Fire Inspections completed with 414 Violations discovered and 235 corrected.</p> <p>- Stations 14 & 20 responded to 407 incidents (including 246 Medical Incidents and 76 Service Calls).</p>
