- There were five civilian fire casualties. One involved a death as a result of a motor vehicle collision and subsequent fire. The other four were minor to moderate injuries. There were no fire deaths involving building fires in 2014. There were two fire service casualties both of which were minor and neither were lost time incidents.
- There were 780 occupancy pre-incident survey updates and 387 hydrant inspections completed twice during 2014.
- Approximately 2,900 children ages 3 to 9 were educated during October's Fire Prevention month in 34 sessions.
- There were 82 Fire Inspections completed with 296 Violations discovered and 121 corrected.
- Fire-Rescue conducted 21 home fire and life safety courtesy inspections and installed 59 smoke detectors during those inspections during 2014.
- Stations 14 & 20 responded to 382 incidents (including 229 Medical Incidents and 78 Service Calls).
