- There were seven civilian fire casualties (five moderate injuries and two minor injuries). There were no fire deaths in 2015. There was one fire service casualty in 2015 which was a moderate, lost-time injury (fall from porch collapse). - There were 738 occupancy pre-incident survey updates and 364 hydrant inspections completed twice during 2015. - Approximately 2,341 children ages 3 to 9 were educated during October's Fire Prevention month in 29 sessions. - There were 89 Fire Inspections completed with 189 Violations discovered and 120 corrected. - Fire-Rescue conducted 25 home fire and life safety courtesy inspections and installed 65 smoke detectors during those inspections during 2015. - Stations 14 & 20 responded to 345 incidents (including 196 Medical Incidents and 62 Service Calls). - NOTE: Stations 31,33,34,35, and 36 are now reported separately in "Calls to Service By Station" above.
