- There were nine civilian fire casualties (7 moderate injuries and 1 minor injury) and one fire death in 2016 that was the result of a mobile home fire. There were no fire service casualties in 2016.

- There were 845 occupancy pre-incident survey updates and 416 hydrant inspections completed twice during 2016.

- Approximately 1,931 children ages 3 to 9 were educated during October's Fire Prevention month in 21 sessions.

- There were 153 Fire Inspections completed with 217 Violations discovered and 145 corrected.

- Fire-Rescue conducted 10 home fire and life safety courtesy inspections and installed 29 smoke detectors during those inspections during 2016.

- Stations 14 & 20 responded to 424 incidents (including 253 Medical Incidents and 79 Service Calls).

- NOTE: 2016 Dollar Loss estimate includes single fire loss of over \$1.6 million on March 9, 2016 at Ashepo Plantation.
