- There were four civilian fire casualties (1 minor injury and 2 moderate/major injuries) and one fire death in 2017 that was the result of a building fire. There were four fire service casualties in 2017 (3 of which were lost time injuries)
- There were 874 occupancy pre-incident survey updates and 417 hydrant inspections completed twice during 2017.
- Approximately 2,000 children ages 3 to 9 were educated during October's Fire Prevention month in 21 sessions.
- There were 133 Fire Inspections completed with 211 Violations discovered and 172 corrected.
- Fire-Rescue conducted 25 home fire and life safety courtesy inspections and installed 75 smoke detectors during those inspections during 2017.
- Stations 14 & 20 responded to 397 incidents (including 205 Medical Incidents and 95 Service Calls).
- NOTE: 2016 Dollar Loss estimate includes single fire loss of over \$1.6 million on March 9, 2016 at Ashepoo Plantation.
