- There were nine civilian fire casualties - 5 minor injuries and 4 fire deaths in 2018 (all the result of a building fires).
- There were 3 fire service casualties in 2018 (1 of which was a lost-time injury)
- There were 584 occupancy pre-incident survey updates and 420 hydrant inspections completed twice during 2017.
- Approximately 1,950 children ages 3 to 9 were educated during October's Fire Prevention month in 21 sessions.
- There were 133 Fire Inspections completed with 138 Violations discovered and 116 corrected.
- Fire-Rescue conducted 65 home fire and life safety courtesy inspections and installed 143 smoke detectors during those inspections during 2018.
- Stations 14 & 20 responded to 353 incidents (including 210 Medical Incidents and 63 Service Calls).
- NOTE: 2018 Dollar Loss estimate includes two fire losses of combined \$3.1 million - 2/27/18 (School) & 9/5/2018 (Plantation House)
