- There were eight civilian fire casualties - 3 minor, 1 moderate, 1 severe injuries & 3 deaths in 2020 (6 in building fires).
- There were two firefighter casualties, one of which was a lost-time incident (COVID-19 related casualties not counted).
- There were 1,041 occupancy pre-incident survey updates and 440 hydrant inspections completed twice during 2020.
- In-person fire prevention sessions were not held in 2020 due to COVID-19. A video was distributed to all schools instead.
- There were 90 Fire Inspections completed with 95 Violations discovered and 71 corrected in 2020.
- Fire-Rescue conducted 24 home fire and life safety courtesy inspections and installed 54 smoke detectors in 2020.
- Stations 14 & 20 responded to 371 incidents (including 234 Medical Incidents and 31 Service Calls) in 2020.

- NOTE: 2018 Dollar Loss estimate includes two fire losses of combined \$3.1 million - 2/27/18 (School) & 9/5/2018 (Plantation House)
