<p><i>*Ambulance responses are no longer tracked separately and have been consolidated into "Medical Incidents"-- \$ amounts in thousands</i></p> <p>- There were eleven civilian fire casualties, including one civilian fire death resulting from an outdoor burning. There were four fire service casualties, two of which were exposures to unprotected eyes.</p> <p>- There were 683 occupancy pre-incident survey updates and 354 hydrant inspections completed twice during 2010.</p> <p>- Approximately 2,800 children ages 3 to 8 were educated during October's Fire Prevention month using 35 educational sessions. An additional 750 children participated in the Safe Kids campaign in March.</p> <p>- There were 50 Fire Inspections completed with 108 Violations discovered and 38 corrected.</p> <p>- Stations 14 &amp; 20 responded to 229 incidents (including 116 Medical Incidents and 52 Service Calls).</p>
