- There were seventeen civilian fire casualties, including one civilian fire death resulting from a motor vehicle fire. There were nine fire service casualties, three of which were moderate severity, lost time incidents.															
- There were 716 occupancy pre-incident survey updates and 354 hydrant inspections completed twice during 2011.															
- Approximately 3,000 children ages 3 to 8 were educated during October's Fire Prevention month using 36 educational sessions. An additional 750 children participated in the Safe Kids campaign in March.															
- There were 111 Fire Inspections completed with 319 Violations discovered and 150 corrected.															
- Stations 14 & 20 responded to 284 incidents (including 184 Medical Incidents and 31 Service Calls).
