- There were three civilian fire casualties - 2 minor injuries and 1 moderate injury in 2019 (all the result of a building fires).
- There was one firefighter casualty that resulted in a lost-time incident.
- There were 994 occupancy pre-incident survey updates and 439 hydrant inspections completed twice during 2019.
- Approximately 1,890 children ages 3 to 9 were educated during October's Fire Prevention month in 21 sessions.
- There were 131 Fire Inspections completed with 107 Violations discovered and 86 corrected.
- Fire-Rescue conducted 49 home fire and life safety courtesy inspections and installed 107 smoke detectors during those inspections during 2019.
- Stations 14 & 20 responded to 376 incidents (including 229 Medical Incidents and 56 Service Calls).
- NOTE: 2018 Dollar Loss estimate includes two fire losses of combined \$3.1 million - 2/27/18 (School) & 9/5/2018 (Plantation House)
