- There were ten civilian fire casualties - 2 minor, 4 moderate & 4 deaths in 2021 (7 in building fires).
- There were three firefighter casualties in 2021, one was a lost-time incident (COVID-19 related casualties not counted).
- There were 1,069 occupancy pre-incident survey updates and 410 hydrant inspections completed twice during 2021.
- In-person fire prevention sessions were not held in 2021 due to COVID-19. A video was distributed to all schools instead.
- There were 143 Fire Inspections completed with 568 Violations discovered and 512 corrected in 2021.
- Fire-Rescue conducted 81 home fire and life safety courtesy inspections and installed 265 smoke detectors in 2021.
- Stations 14 & 20 responded to 410 incidents (including 256 Medical Incidents and 31 Service Calls) in 2021.

- NOTE: 2018 Dollar Loss estimate includes two fire losses of combined \$3.1 million - 2/27/18 (School) & 9/5/2018 (Plantation House)
