- **There were no fire deaths in Colleton County in 2025.** There were 7 civilian fire casualties 4 minor, 2 moderate and 1 severe.
- There were three firefighter casualties in 2025, one was minor, one was moderate, and one was a lost-time incident.
- There were 638 occupancy pre-incident survey updates and 360 hydrant inspections completed twice during 2025.
- Approximately 2,500 children were educated during 17 Fire Prevention sessions in 2025.
- There were 194 Fire Inspections completed with 201 Violations discovered and 180 corrected in 2025.
- Fire-Rescue conducted 84 home fire and life safety courtesy inspections and installed 252 smoke alarms in 2025.
- Fire-Rescue's Emergency Operations Center was activated twelve times during 2025 for various weather events.
- 279 Fire-Rescue members made 6,355 training class contacts in 669 classes for 30,900 training hours in 2025.





CCFR 2025 Calls for Service (CFS) by Station Response Area




CCFR 2025 Calls for Service (CFS) by District
